3. work with their directors to submit unpublished male choir pieces for the IMC Library;
4. use their group's existing alumni networks to let their group's alumni know about post-collegiate IMC member choruses they can sing in after graduation.

Student delegates who successfully complete their duties will receive support from IMC for their attendance at the National Seminar at Miami University, Oxford, Ohio, March 18-20, 2010, including registration fee waiver and housing, and will be able to apply for funds to defray individual travel costs.
